Welcome to Troop 45. We want your scout's transition from Cub Scouts to Boy Scouts to be as smooth as possible. It's a big change, so please take note of the information included in this sheet.

Applications. In order to complete the transition to Boy Scouts, we need a Boy Scout Youth Application form. Please fill out an application and return it to Assistant Scoutmaster Frank Roberts.

Troop Meetings. Unlike the Cub Scout pack, the Boy Scout troop meets every week, year round. We meet in the Hanover Community Center in the winter and at Storrs Pond Area 5 in the summer. Meetings are at 7:00 pm every Wednesday. The meeting ends at 8:45 (with possible cleanup activities for a few minutes afterwards). *Please be sure your scout has a way home.* Your scout's first meeting will be Wednesday, 9 April. We look forward to seeing you there!

Uniforms. If your scout does not already have a Boy Scout uniform, he will need one soon. We require the tan shirt with council patch, troop numerals, and world crest sewn on correctly. We will provide red epaulets as part of the Crossover ceremony and will issue a troop neckerchief at the induction ceremony at June Parents Night.

Handbooks. We will issue your scout a new *Boy Scout Handbook* as part of the New Scout Training program. Your scout will need his handbook at every troop meeting until he reaches First Class.

New Scout Training. Between now and the end of June, the troop is focused on integrating the new Scouts and training them to advance to Tenderfoot. We want your scout to be recognized with this rank advancement at Parents Night on 18 June. In order to complete all the requirements for Tenderfoot, your scout will need to attend most of the weekly meetings between now and then. And be sure to reserve Wednesday, 18 June on your own calendar!

Parent Meeting. You have questions; we have answers. We even have answers for questions you didn't know you had. Please come to the Parents Meeting on Wednesday, 9 April. Drop your scout off for his first troop meeting, and stick around for the Parents Meeting.
